

New Mandatory Data Breach Notification Laws

On 13th Feb, 2017, the Australian Senate passed a bill establishing a mandatory requirement to notify the Privacy Commissioner. The New Data Breach Notification Law is slated to take effect on 22nd Feb, 2018 if no earlier date is proclaimed.

WHO IS AFFECTED?

Organisations with an annual turnover of \$3 million +

WHAT MUST BE DONE?

Organisations must notify the Privacy Commissioner and all affected customers of every privacy data breach

WHICH DATA IS INVOLVED?

All incidents involving PII, PCI, credit eligibility and tax file numbers

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

Failure to comply may result in fines of \$360,000 for individuals and \$1.8 million for organisations

WHEN DOES IT START?

It is highly probably the legislation will become law in the next 12 months

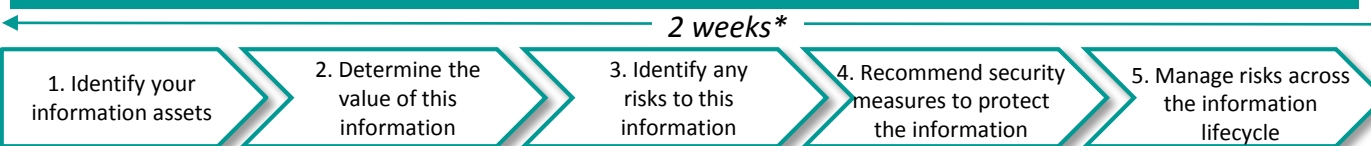
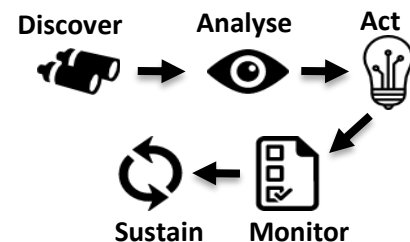
